FESTIVAL — JOHNNY PITRE

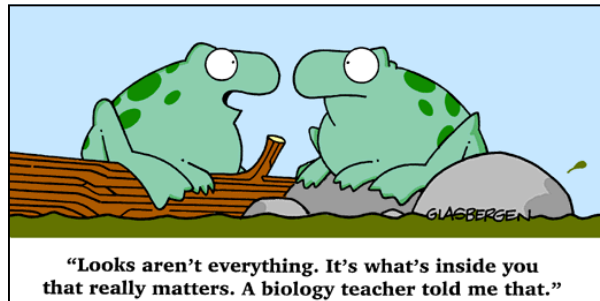
